





Size: UK 10 (14) - US 6 (10) - EU 36 (40) Note: figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes. Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 3 (4) balls (each ball 50g and 100m) of Grenada yarn (50% Cotton, 50% Micromodal) shade no. 30458 Needles: A pair of 3.75mm knitting needles Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: GARTER STITCH (G ST): Knit throughout, skipping yarn bobbles and working with straight yarn into K stitches.

TENSION

6 bobble over garter stitch with 3.75mm needles

measure 10cm in width. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with 3.75mm needles cast on 29 (31) sts, corresponding to 28 (30) yarn bobbles and work in garter stitch. When Back measures 28 (30)cm from beg, shape sleeves by casting on 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then continue to work in garter st on all sts as before. When Back measures 48 (52)cm from beg, cast off all sts.

Front: work as Back.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams, corresponding to 12 (14) sts and 11 (13) bobbles on either side, then sew sleeve and side seams.
