# EMERALD COAST PULL

LANA GATTO

**One Size:** 10/12 UK - 6/8 USA - 36/38 EU

**Skill Level:** advanced

**How much yarn:** g 400 of Sugar yarn,  
in green shade no. 7652

**Needles:** A 5.00mm (no. 6) crochet hook

**Sewing needle:** Yarn needle with rounded point

## STITCHES

**Using crochet hook:** chain (ch) - Slip stitch (ss)  
Double crochet (dc), treble (tr), triple treble (tr tr).

**CROSSED STITCH PATTERN:** (work over an even number of sts)

**Row 1:** ch 3 (= 1 tr), \* miss 1 st, work 1 tr into next st, then work 1 tr into missed st; rep from \* ending with 1 tr into last st. Rep this row. **FLOWER PATTERN:** (work over a multiple of 7 sts.) **Round 1:** 1 dc in each st of previous round, end with 1 ss into first dc. **Round 2:** 1 ss into first st, ch 5 and 2 tr tr without working last closure, \* miss 6 dc, into next dc work 2 tr tr without working last closure, wrap yarn around hook and draw through all loops on hook (there are 2 clusters of 2 tr tr each closed together), ch 5, 1 ss into same st, ch 5 and 2 tr tr without working last closure; rep from \* all around, end as follows: miss 6 dc, into first st of this round work 3 tr tr without working last closure, wrap yarn around hook and draw through all loops on hook (there are 2 clusters of 5 tr tr - 2 tr tr and 3 tr tr - closed together). **Round 3:** 1 ss into closure of last 5 clusters, into same place work 1 ss, ch 5 and 2 tr tr without working last closure; \* into next closure of 4 clusters work 2 tr tr without working last closure, wrap yarn around hook and draw through all loops on hook (there are 2 clusters of 2 tr tr each closed together), ch 5, 1 ss into same st, ch 5 and 2 tr tr without working last closure; rep from \* all around, ending with 3 tr tr without working last closure, wrap yarn around hook and draw through all loops on hook (there are 2 clusters of 5 tr tr - 2 tr tr and 3 tr tr - closed together). **Round 4:** 1 dc into closure of last 5 clusters, ch 6, \* 1 dc into next closure of 4 clusters, ch 6; rep from \* ending with a ss into first dc. **Round 5:** 1 dc into same dc, 7 dc into next arch; \* 1 dc into next dc, 7 dc into next arch; rep from \* ending with a ss into first dc. **Round 6:** as Round 2 but miss 7 dc between clusters instead of 6 dc. **Round 7:** as Round 3. **Round 8:** as Round 4 but ch 7 instead of ch 6 for each arch. **Round 9:** as Round 5, but work 8 dc instead of 7 dc in each arch.

## TENSIONS

19 sts and 10 rows/rounds measure 10cm square over treble and crossed stitch with 5.00 mm (no. 6) hook. 18 sts and 8 rounds measure 10cm square over flower patt with 5.00 mm (no. 6) hook. **Note:** tension is not critical for this project. You can adjust patt working more or less rows/rounds.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Back and front - Lower Part:** work in one piece, top down. With 5.00mm (no. 6) crochet hook ch 161, join with a ss into first ch to form a ring and work as follows: 9 rounds in flower patt (at end of 9th round there are 207 sts), 1 round of trebles dec 15 sts evenly (192 sts remain) and 1 round in crossed st patt. Then work 9 rounds in flower patt as follows: on 2nd round miss 7 dc between clusters, on 4th round make ch7-arches; on 5th round work 8dc in each arch, on 6th round miss 8 dc between clusters, on 8th round make ch7-arches and on 9th round work 8dc in each arch. There are 216 sts. Work 1 round of trebles and 1 round in crossed st patt. Then

work 9 rounds in flower patt as follows: on 2nd round miss 8 dc between clusters, on 4th round make ch7-arches; on 5th round work 8dc in each arch, on 6th round miss 8 dc between clusters, on 8th round make ch7-arches and on 9th round work 7 dc in each arch. When work measures 39 cm from beg, fasten off.

**Upper Part:** work in one piece, until to armholes. With 5.00mm (no. 6) crochet hook work on opposite side of Lower Part foundation ch and work 6 rounds of trebles, inc 24 sts evenly across 1st round and dec 15 sts evenly across 6th round. At end of 6th round (approx 6 cm from beg) divide piece to form Back and Front separately and cont to work in back-and-forth rows.

**Back:** over first 70 sts work 7 rows of trebles, 1 row in crossed st patt, 1 row of trebles, 11 rows in crossed st patt and 1 row of dc. When armholes measures 20 cm, fasten off.

**Front:** miss first 13 sts of unworked sts (space for armhole) and work 1 tr into each of next 74 sts, turn (leaving space for other armhole) and cont to work on these 74 sts as given for Back, omitting 2 sts at each end twice: 66 sts remain. At the same time, when armholes measures 2cm, shape neck: divide work in half and cont to work separately on either side, dec on neckedge 1 st every row 16 times (for dec, tr 2 tog). When armholes measures 20cm, fasten off.

**Sleeves - Lower part:** work in one piece, top down. With 5.00mm (no. 6) crochet hook ch 64, join with a ss into first ch to form a ring and work 9 rounds in flower patt as follows: on 2nd round, miss 7 dc between clusters, on 4th round make ch6-arches; on 5th round work 7dc in each arch, on 6th round miss 7 dc between clusters, on 8th round make ch6-arches and on 9th round work 7dc in each arch. Work 1 round of trebles dec 8 sts evenly spaced, 1 round in crossed st patt and 9 rounds in flower patt as previous 9 rounds. When work measures 23cm from beg, fasten off.

**Upper part:** work in one piece, until to armholes. With 5.00mm (no. 6) crochet hook work on opposite side of Lower Part foundation ch and work 6 rounds of trebles dec 4 sts evenly spaced across first round. At end of 6th round (approx 6cm from beg) cont to work top of sleeve in back-and-forth rows on first 50 sts. Work 13 rows as follows: 7 rows of trebles, 1 row in crossed st patt, 1 row of trebles and 4 rows in crossed st patt. At the same time, at each end every row dec 2 sts twice, dec 1 st 9 times, dec 2 sts twice. When sleeve top measures approx 13cm, fasten off.

## FINISHING

Join shoulders with a row of ss on WS of work, inserting hook for each st into both pieces, in correspondence. **Neck border:** work a round of dc, starting and ending at one shoulder seam. End with a ss into first dc. Fasten off. Set in sleeves.
